Plan smart, start early

Here are some tips to get you started as you work towards your exams

FROM 6TH FEBRUARY

Understand the Exam Format & Requirements

Look at the exam board specifications to understand what topics will be tested. Be clear on their format, so you know what to expect.

Assess Strengths & Weaknesses

Do a quick review of all topics to see what you already understand and what needs more work. Use the traffic light system (= confident, = needs work, = struggle) to track subjects and topics.

Gather Resources & Materials

Organise class notes, textbooks, and revision guides.

Download past papers and mark schemes from exam board websites.

Plan a Study Routine (Without Overloading)

Make a realistic revision timetable (if you do not have one already) but keep it flexible for the moment.

Set small, achievable goals, like reviewing one tricky topic per week.

Get into Good Study Habits

Start practicing active recall (e.g., summarising notes, testing yourself).

Find a revision style that works for you—whether it's flashcards, mind maps, or voice notes. Build a consistent study routine to make revision feel manageable, not overwhelming.
